Actress Kimberly Estrada, who played the boxer Perez in the Oscar-winning ***Million Dollar Baby***, starred in ***Day of Miracles*** as a woman who is in one of the World Trade Center buildings on Sept. 11, 2001. She dies and is brought back to life.

"I think there's a rising importance of spiritual messages in conscious media that comes to the forefront and my goal as an actress is acting in commercially lucrative films with a message that is spiritual and one people need to hear," Estrada said. "Conscious media means pieces of work that really have a message that goes above and beyond pure entertainment -- that makes people think about life and examine values about where society's headed, the earth and what we're doing to the earth and how we treat each other."

Though she didn't make much money the first time, Estrada hopes to work with Smith and McRay again.

"They were an absolute joy from start to finish and the film was a real labor of love," Estrada said.
